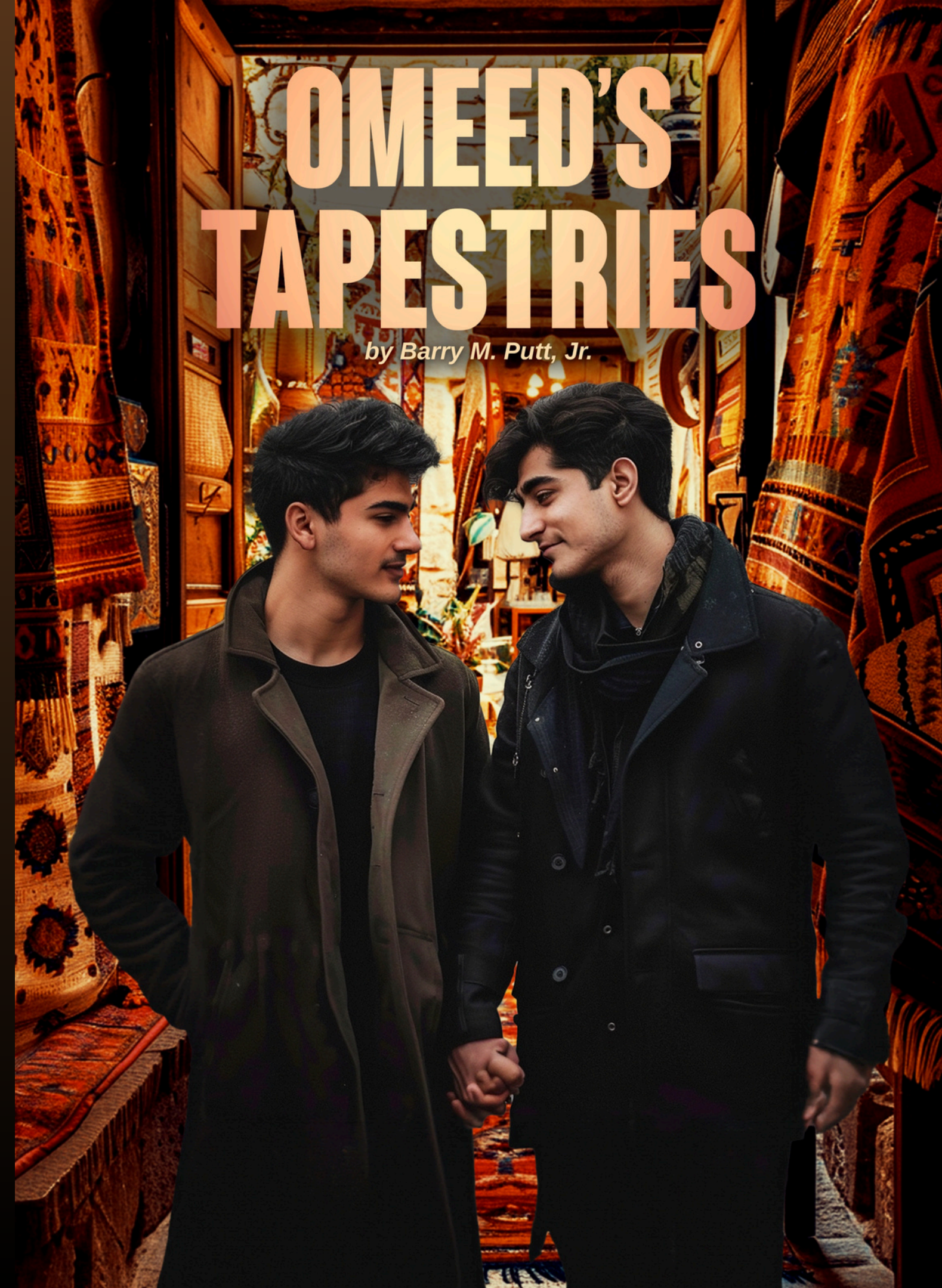

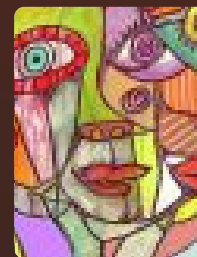

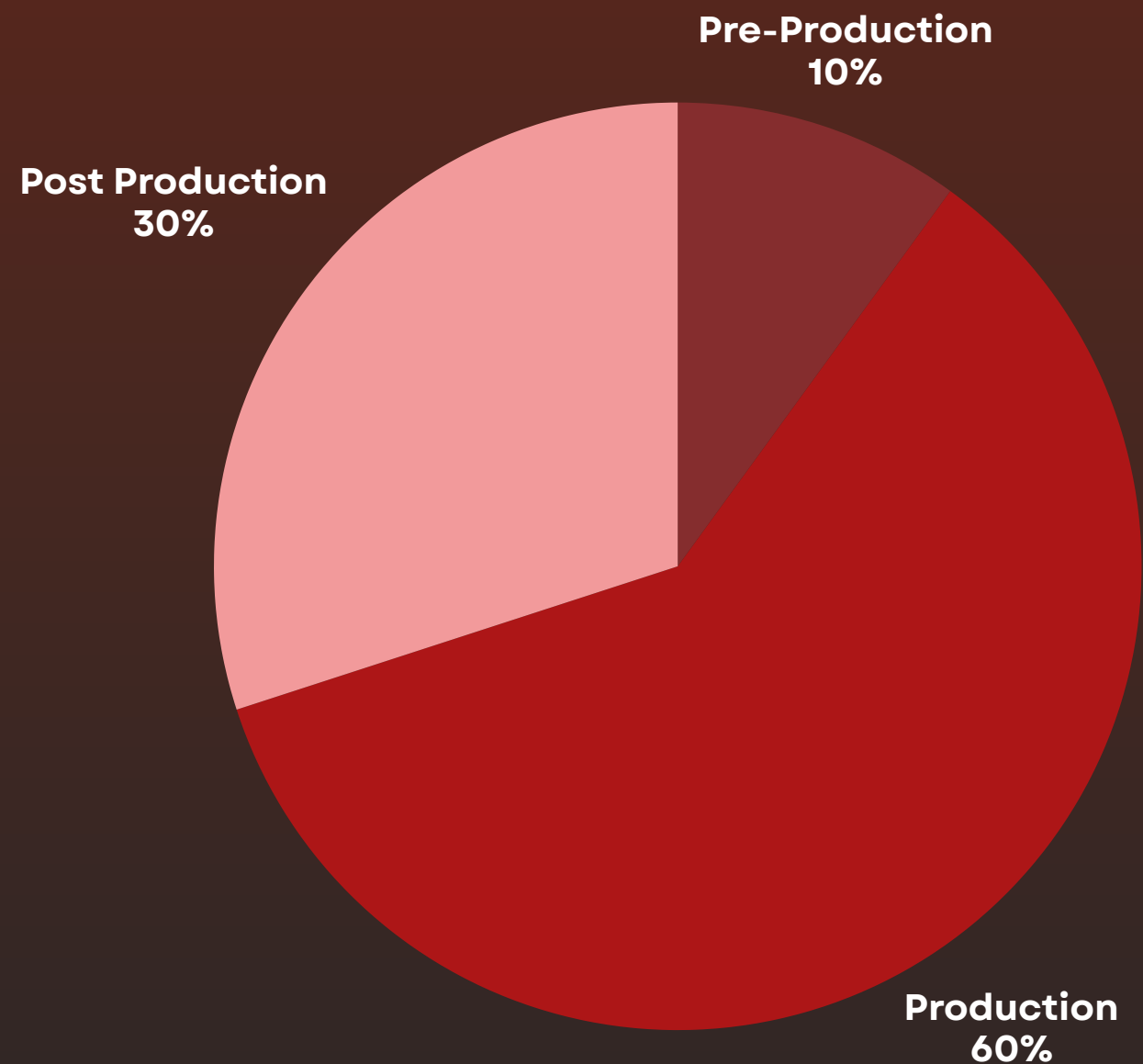
Interview with Santa Barbara Screenplay Awards

In a showcase interview with the organization, the writer shares how he feels about his role as a writer:

“As a screenwriter, I strive to write feature films and TV series that are entertaining yet give the audience something to think about. Film and TV are dynamic intimate mediums. I aim to use them to bring people together and increase understanding and unity for all.”

SCREENPLAY BUDGET: \$95,000 – \$195,000

Our vast imagination for this project makes the timeline and budget flexible, with a little under \$100,000 being a starting point.



- **Pre-Production:** \$12,000 – \$25,000
- **Production:** \$51,000 – \$110,000
- **Post-Production:** \$31,000 – \$60,000

STAGEPLAY BUDGET

\$25,000 – \$51,000

For independent, short term productions

- **Pre-Production:** \$9,000 – \$18,000
- **Design & Tech:** \$5,500 – \$15,500
- **Production Staff:** \$2,250 – \$6,500
- **Admin & Legal:** \$1,000 – \$2,500+
- **Marketing:** \$1,000 – \$2,500
- **Contingency:** \$2,000 – \$4,000
- **Cast:** 6 actors at the AEA minimum of \$750/each = \$4,500

For large scale, contracted productions

*+ weekly running costs **\$22,000 – \$100,000**

- **Pre-Production:** \$35,000 – \$135,000+
- **Design & Tech:** \$41,000 – \$195,000
- **Production Staff:** \$30,000 – \$100,000
- **Admin & Legal:** \$7,000 – \$25,000
- **Marketing:** \$20,000 – \$100,000
- **Contingency:** \$10,000 – \$50,000
